Vermont Avenue, in the Student Union building's third floor multipurpose room. Attendance is free for SEIU Local 99 members, who will also be given paid release time to attend the conference if needed, but the conference is open to anyone.

"As LACCD Board President, I'm excited to co-sponsor the event and I'm pleased that the District is able to bring this training opportunity to our SEIU members, many of whom are part of our custodial staff and are rarely offered professional development and career enhancement opportunities," Hoffman said. "We hope attendees will be inspired to new levels of success through fun, powerful, breakthrough activities that will help women overcome personal and professional barriers, and gain new confidence in a safe, non-judgmental environment."
