JOB INFORMATION FAIR FOR ACADEMIC POSITIONS PLANNED MARCH 2, 2019

LOS ANGELES—Prospective candidates interested in applying for probationary, tenure-track academic positions within the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) are encouraged to attend a special Job Information Fair from 9 a.m. to Noon, Saturday, March 2, 2019, at Los Angeles Trade-Technical College, 400 W. Washington Blvd., in Downtown Los Angeles.

The LACCD intends to fill about 80 full-time academic positions available throughout the District at its nine colleges in time for the Fall 2019 Semester. Applications are **only** accepted online at: <http://laccd.edu/Employment/Pages/Academic-Jobs.aspx>.

This is the first time in several years that the LACCD has initiated such a large recruitment for academic positions, according to Albert Roman, D.P.A., Vice Chancellor of Human Resources. The Job Information Fair will allow interested applicants to meet with faculty and staff representatives from the District and its nine colleges and to also attend workshops about the application process. Information tables for the colleges will be available.

“This is not your typical job fair. While applications will not be accepted on site, this informational job fair will provide a unique opportunity for candidates to directly learn more about each campus, who we are and what we do before they apply,” Roman said.

Dozens of teaching positions are available through the online application process in a variety of disciplines, from accounting, biology, computer sciences and math to film production, political science, nursing and counseling services. Positions are full-time probationary tenure-track.

In addition to meeting with District and college representatives, attendees will be able to attend several brief workshops, including:

- How to complete an employment application for academic positions at LACCD.
- Tips on putting together a successful teaching demonstration that is required as part of the application process.
- Listen and learn from various Department Chairs on what they look for during the application process.

Limited, free parking will be available at Trade-Tech for attendees on a first-come, first-served basis in parking lots off Olive Street and 24th Street.
