Statement on U.S. Supreme Court Deadlocked Vote on Immigration Reform

The Los Angeles Community College District is deeply disappointed by the U.S. Supreme Court failure to issue a decision on President Barack Obama's immigration reform plan which would have protected millions of undocumented people from deportation.
