# **Either/Both** for: Sexual Assault, Hate Crimes, Domestic/ **Dating Violence**, Stalking

## **Campus or District** Administration for:

**Discrimination and/or** Harassment Based on: Race, Color, National Origin, Religion, Sex/Gender, Physical or Mental Disability, Age (40+), Genetic Information, Marital Status, **Sexual Orientation and** Identity, AIDS/HIV Status, Medical Condition, Military or Veteran Status, or Status as a Victim of Domestic Violence, Assault, or Stalking Under **California Law**

# Law Enforcement
