STUDENT ACCESS TO OUTDOOR DRIVE-UP WIFI AT LACCD COLLEGES

BACKGROUND

The Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) and its nine colleges have initiated plans to provide students with reliable, high-speed internet access (WiFi) at specific drive-up sites to help students during the COVID-19 pandemic. The WiFi sites are being operated for students in accordance with the prevailing [Health Orders](#) and other health and safety guidelines per the [Los Angeles County Department of Public Health](#) (LACDPH). All students must adhere to all LACDPH Health Orders and safety guidelines as noted below and posted online while accessing the drive-up WiFi spaces at the colleges. Students can access any of the colleges' WiFi lots, but must first check the college's website for any specific reservations needed and for the hours of operations.

BEFORE ENTERING THE CAMPUS

- Go to the website for the college that you plan to visit for any WiFi lot reservation requirements; verify the hours of operations and complete the "COVID-19 Symptom Self Check" assessment. Be prepared to confirm you completed the questionnaire.
- Check your LACCD student email daily for updates and other messages that could impact changes to the WiFi lots and/or your ability to access the college.
- If you are sick for any reason, DO NOT COME to campus. Notify your instructor if you are sick and could not access the WiFi lot for class or instruction purposes.
- Access is for students in vehicles only. No pedestrians, bicycles or motorcycles allowed.
- No restrooms will be available at the WiFi drive-up lots.

BRING ANY REQUIRED WATER, FOOD AND MEDICATIONS TO CAMPUS

- No water fountains, on-site food sales or vending machines are available. You will not be allowed to exit your vehicle while in the WiFi lot.
- Trash cans will not be available. Take away all trash you generate while at the WiFi lot.

TO ENTER AND EXIT THE COLLEGE WIFI LOT

- All students are required to use the colleges' check-in process before going to designated WiFi parking lot and to check-out prior to leaving the college.
- Remain in your vehicle during the check-in and check-out process.
- After check-in, look for "WiFi Lot" directional signs for entrances and exits.
- Facial covering and social distancing are required for check-in and check-out.

COVID-19 SYMPTOM CHECK AT CHECK-IN

- You will be asked for your online SYMPTOM SELF-CHECK results.
- If you have not taken the online SYMPTOM SELF-CHECK, you must truthfully answer:
 1. *Do you have NEW or WORSENING onset of any of the following symptoms in the past 14 days: Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting?*
 2. *Are you living with any person who is experiencing or exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms, or has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or have you had contact with someone known to be positive with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?*
 3. *If you have not traveled outside of the state/country OR have traveled outside the state/country and are fully vaccinated, please answer "No" below. If you have traveled outside of the country/state in the past 14 days and are not fully vaccinated,*

- If all answers are NO, the student is cleared to proceed to the WiFi drive-up lot.
- If any answer is YES, the student will be directed to go home.
- If check-in personnel observe any COVID-19 symptoms when you arrive on campus for check-in, access can be denied and you will be reminded to contact your instructor(s).

WHILE USING THE WIFI DRIVE-UP LOT

- Facial coverings are required during check-in and check-out, but while in your car at the WiFi Lot, with windows up, facial coverings can be removed.
- Remain in your vehicle at all times.
- Park only in designated spots to leave at least one parking spot open between vehicles.
- Maintain social-distancing protocols at all times.
- No restroom facilities will be available.
- Students can access the WiFi only with their valid student email account and password.
- Report safety issues to your instructor, or the nearest campus official.
