A. **ELECT REPRESENTATIVE TO ELECT MEMBERS TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL DISTRICT ORGANIZATION – 2013-2014**

I move that Trustee _____ be elected to serve as the Los Angeles Community College District's governing board voting representative to elect members to the Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization. (Education Code §35023/72403).

Background: Education Code §35023. The governing board of each school district of every kind or class shall annually at its initial meeting select one of its members as its representative who shall have one vote for each member to be elected to the county committee provided by Article 1 (commencing with Section 4000) of Chapter 1 of Part 3. The secretary or clerk of the district shall furnish the county superintendent of schools with a certificate naming the representative selected by the board.

Education Code §72403. The governing board of each community college district shall annually at its initial meeting select one of its members to serve as its representative for purposes of Article 1 (commencing with Section 4000) of Chapter 1 of Part 3. The representative selected pursuant to this section shall have one vote for each member to be elected to the county committee pursuant to Article 1 (commencing with Section 4000) of Chapter 1 of Part 3.

B. **SELECT ANNUAL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY SCHOOL TRUSTEES ASSOCIATION (LACSTA) FOR 2013-2014**

I move that Trustee _____ be selected to serve as the Los Angeles Community College District's governing board Annual Representative to the Los Angeles County School Trustees Association for 2013-2014.

Background: The representative shall perform duties as described in Standing Rule Number 6 which states that each school board will be asked to select a board member at their organizational meeting to serve as the LACSTA representative. The representative's role is to a) vote on all Association matters; and b) communicate between the Executive Board, the Association, and the local board.

This is a separate position from that of the voting delegate for the annual county committee election, unless the Board chooses to name the same person to handle both responsibilities.

I. AUTHORIZE A LIFE INSURANCE CARRIER CHANGE

Authorize a contract with Cigna Group Insurance underwritten by Life Insurance of North America, a Cigna Company to provide basic and voluntary life insurance and basic and voluntary accidental death and dismemberment insurance to the District employees during the period of January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016 (3 years).

Background: The proposed award is the result of a Request for Proposal (RFP) issued by Wells Fargo Insurance Services USA, Inc. on April 1, 2013. The RFP was sent to 15 vendors that specialize in life insurance products with a response deadline of May 1, 2013. Thirteen carriers submitted proposals and 2 declined to participate. Six carriers were selected as finalists based on their ratings of A to A+, their ability to adhere to the guidelines of the RFP and the plan design requested (which required them to match or better the current MetLife coverage terms) as well as their competitive rates.

As a result of the evaluation and phone interview, Cigna Group Insurance company was selected based on administrative capabilities and most competitive price. The change in vendor will result in an estimated net savings of \$200,592 in District-paid basic life premiums and an additional \$61,277 in savings for the voluntary life plans presently held by employees. The recommendation for the above services is made by the JLMBC and Business Services as the outcome of a thorough evaluation through the RFP process

Action

Authorize a contract with Alpha 1 Construction to provide general construction services for the Second Access Road (Slope Stabilization) project at West Los Angeles College at a cost of \$519,190. Consistent with Board Rule 7100.10, authorize the Executive Director of Facilities Planning and Development to authorize change orders of up to ten percent (10%), the maximum allowed by law without re-bidding, subject to subsequent Board ratification.

Background

This contract is the result of formal competitive bidding. Twelve contractors requested bid packets. Three responsive bids were received ranging from \$519,190 to \$747,500. This contract is for the construction necessary to stabilize the slope adjacent to College Boulevard as required by of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works.

Award History

This contract represents the second award to this company through the Bond Program and a cumulative original award total of \$668,391. A previous award was given to this company for the Renovate CPM Trailer (FF&E-Trade) project at Los Angeles Trade-Technical College.

Funding and Development Phase

Funding is through Measure J Bond proceeds. College Boulevard - Second Access Road 39W.5981.01.02. Construction Phase.

Subject: **ADOPT BOARD RULE 2420 – GUN-FREE CAMPUSES**

The following motion is presented by Trustee Svonkin.

Adopt Board Rule 2420 as follows:

2420. GUN-FREE CAMPUSES

Possession or display of firearms of any kind shall not be allowed on the principal campuses of the District except by law enforcement officials, for theatrical performances, or by others that may have been issued a license or permit that allows the possession of a firearm on campus. This prohibition shall apply even where a firearm is not operational.

Background: This motion is brought in light of ever-increasing, lethal violence on campuses throughout the United States. The presence of firearms, even when nonoperational and in the instructional setting, lends itself to the potential for panic and fear. In the Fall of 2012, the Criminal Justice Discipline Committee determined that the District's related Administrative Regulation was no longer necessary because the credit program conducted firearms education and training at off-site locations, and the regulation was suspended.
