#### Enrollment Update Budget and Finance Committee March 21, 2018

#### A. 2017-18 FTES Projection

The current 2017-18 FTES projection by semester is shown in Table 1 (below). Considering all semesters reported to date (Summer II, Fall, Winter, and Spring), there has been a 6.2% decline in FTES from 2016-17 to 2017-18. The 2017-18 projection reflects the shift of summer FTES and incomplete reporting for some positive attendance classes.
