Brief Summary of the Topic(s) Discussed

Document entitled "Holland & Knight, May 16, 2018" and "Federal Accomplishments was distributed.

Ms. Leslie Pollner, Senior Policy Advisor, Holland & Knight, discussed various issues of concern regarding the House GOP efforts to move the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) legislation directly on to the House floor by officially introducing the "discharge petition." She continued to discuss the Presidential Task Force on Apprenticeship Expansion Submits Final Report and the House Appropriations Committee work schedule.

Ms. Jennifer McKee discussed various issues of concern regarding the Promoting Real Opportunity, Success, and Prosperity through Education Reform (PROSPER) Act.

Dr. Dale Shimasaki, Chief Executive Officer of Strategic Education, gave a PowerPoint presentation and discussed the document with respect to the following Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) sponsored bills:

- AB 2306 (Santiago) Cal Grant Program
- AB 2575 (Santiago) Dual Enrollment for Private School Students
- AB 3101 (Carrillo) Revise CCCApply
- SB 1009 (Wilk) Apportionment funding for tutoring
LACCD Position: Support

- SB 1406 (Hill) Extend sunset of BA Degree Pilot Program to January 1, 2026. LACCD Position: Support

Dr. Shimasaki indicated that Strategic Education Services produced and distributed a LACCD Legislative matrix to the Committee for its review and feedback in terms of particular bills of interest which will be addressed accordingly at a future Committee meeting.

A question and answer session was conducted regarding the presentation.

Mr. Mark MacDonald, Legislative Advocate, McCallum Group, Inc., provided a PowerPoint presentation entitled "2018-19 Budget Update" and discussed key components of the Budget Process, Major Changes in the May Revise, Funding Formula, Funding Formula (Success Points), Funding Formula (other Issues), Categorical Programs, and the College Promise Campaign implementation of AB 19.
