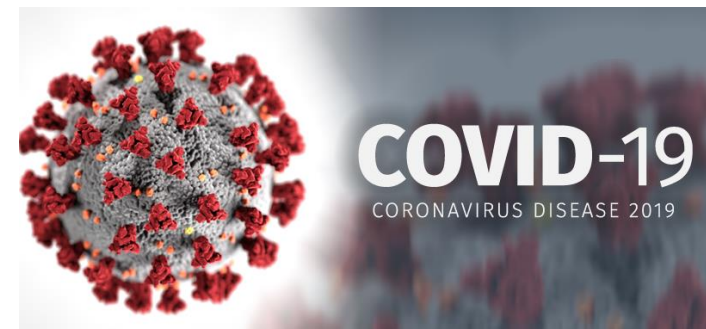

# COVID-19 / STATISTICS



- Four and half months activation for District Emergency Operations Center & Colleges' Incident Command Centers
- Fall 2020 Semester – Third instruction term in remote learning following Spring 2020 semester and Summer session
- COVID-19 cases statewide 520,000 positive; 9,500 deaths
- L.A. County stats: 195,600 positive; 4,750 deaths
- In LACCD:
  - 116 positive cases
  - 1 fatality
  - 34 suspected cases
  - 66 possible exposures

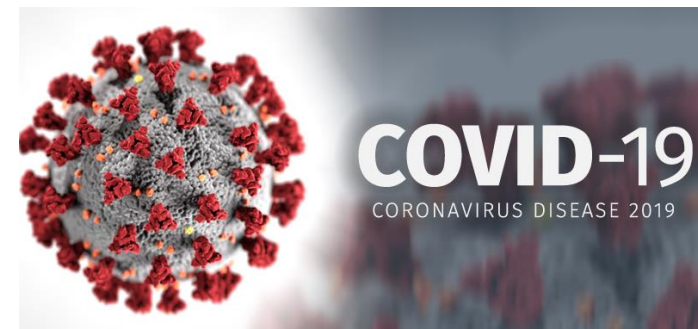


# COVID-19 / EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

- Two active drive-through testing sites; one new under review
  - ELAC April – December
  - L.A. Southwest temporary in June with Kroger partnership
  - L.A. Valley site request under review
- Online public information for District community

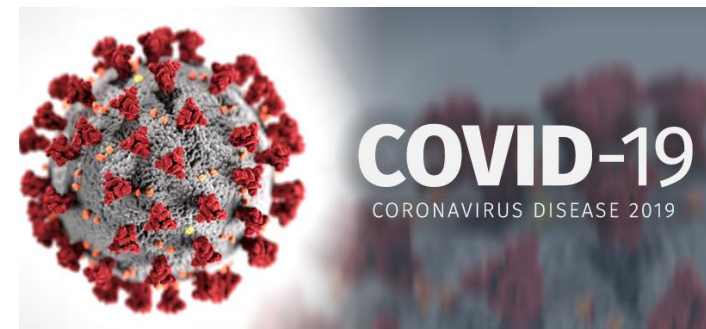

## COVID-19 / PPE

- 3,500 COVID-19 safety signs deployed to colleges and District facilities
- 35,000 reusable face coverings on order
- State emergency supplies received and distributed to colleges:
  - 7 Million disposable surgical masks
  - 70 thermometers
  - 7,016 gallons of hand sanitizer
  - 3 boxes of N95s
  - 2,339 disposable face shields
