## **COMMENCEMENT 2019 TIMES, LOCATIONS SET FOR LACCD'S NINE COLLEGES**

Tuesday, June 4, 2019 will be a busy day for thousands of students, their families and friends who will attend commencement exercises for the nine colleges of the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD). The District expects to award more than 24,000 degrees and certificates to the students of the Class of 2019. Ceremonies are listed in chronological order by starting time.
