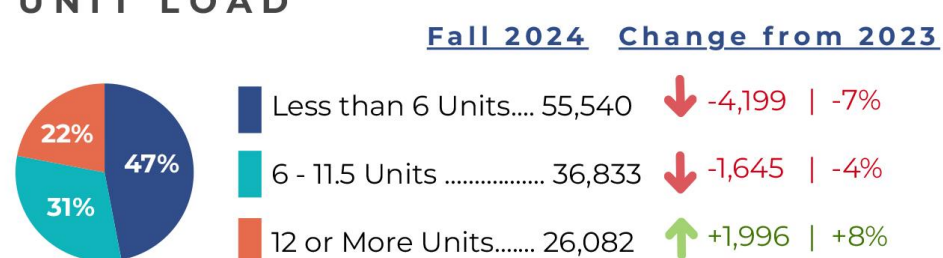

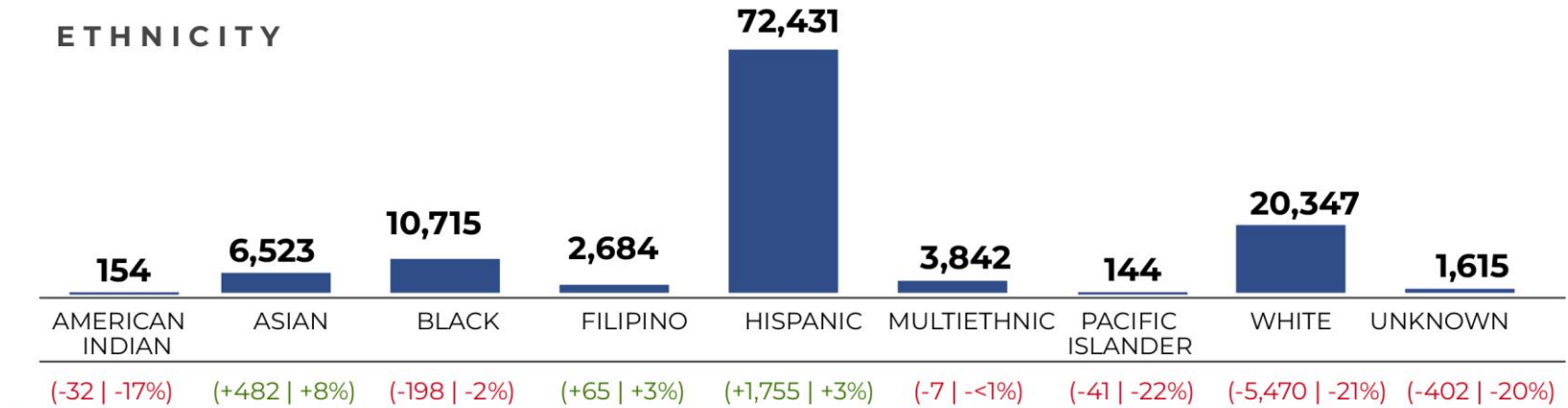

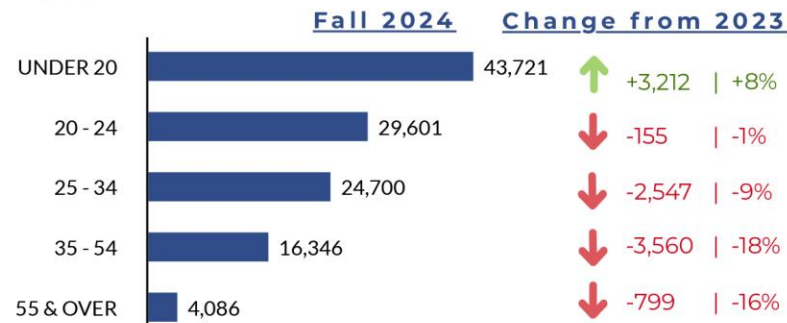

Enrollment Update – Fall 2024



Fall 2024 Credit Enrollment Update:

Comparing Fall 2024 to Fall 2023 (as day 42 of the semester)

Districtwide

- Student credit headcount is down by 3%
- Enrollment is unchanged
- Class offerings are down by 1%
- Enrollment per section is up by 1%
 - 47% of classes are being taught remotely
 - 45% are in-person
 - 8% are hybrid
- Remote classes have the highest fill rate (82%) followed by hybrid (79%) and in-person classes (71%).
