

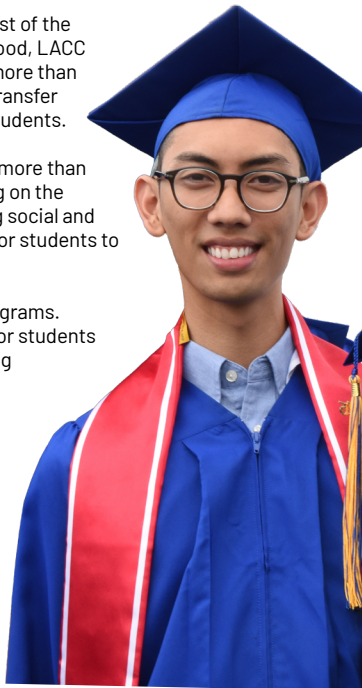
## LOS ANGELES CITY COLLEGE
