West is also one of only a handful of California community colleges authorized to offer two bachelor's degrees. Focusing on the social justice aspects of climate change, West is the only community college in the region to offer an Associate Degree in Climate Change & Environmental Studies and we are home to the California Center for Climate Change Education. Located minutes from Downtown Culver City, a top creative center in the nation, West has relationships with local studios via a unique program that prepares students for behind-the-scenes film/ TV production careers such as grip or set construction. At West, first-time freshman of any income or age can qualify for the \$0 Tuition Promise Program for up to two years, so long as they attend full-time and are California residents. Promise students receive additional financial assistance for education-related expenses such as books, and even rent or transportation.

Students not in the Promise Program may still qualify for free tuition through fee waivers and state and/or federal grants.

IN-LANGUAGE LEARNING

At West, students can earn a Certificate in Child Development by attending classes conducted in Spanish. This path, designed for English learners, allows students to advance professionally and financially while also improving their English language competency. Even the college application can be completed in Spanish. West plans to extend "in-language" paths to other academic areas.

These paths are possible thanks to the passage of the 2023 California Bill AB 1096, which sought to make college more accessible.

CLIMATE CHANGE ACTION

West plays a vital role in filling the climate change education and training gap. With the creation of the State's only California Center for Climate Change Education on West's campus, the College is the new, green epicenter for environmental education and innovation. The Center is focused exclusively on climate change solutions and job creation to meet to meet future workforce demands. The Center was funded through a \$5-million state allocation and \$1.3 million in federal dollars.

West is the only CA community college that offers an Associate Degree in Climate Change & Environmental Studies.
